



Frequently Asked Questions – CCA Enrollment

1. How much are tuition and fees for the 2021-22 school year? Are there any discounts?

2. Do you offer tuition assistance? How do I apply for it?

Yes, we have a limited amount of tuition assistance to award each school year. CCA receives financial assistance donations specifically designated to support low-income families. Our financial assistance committee strives to be a good steward of these donations by supporting families who qualify as low income. First, families must complete the enrollment process (including the payment of enrollment fees), and then they can submit an application for tuition assistance on the FACTS website. (FACTS Grant & Aid Application). After your application is reviewed, the administration will contact you with an offer of assistance (if you qualify), and you have the option to accept it or decline it. (If you do not end up receiving enough aid to be able to afford to come, you can decline the offer, withdraw your student, and your enrollment fees will be refunded.) Applications for tuition assistance will not be reviewed until enrollment is complete.

3. What does the enrollment process look like for families who are new to the school?

Step 1 – Through the enrollment link on the school website (www.ccak12.net), create an application account and a student application. Complete and submit an application for each student. The school will be notified once the application is submitted.

Step 2 – CCA will import the data into RenWeb, and you will receive an email outlining the steps for completing the second half of the enrollment process. (Creating a ParentsWeb account, and then logging in to access enrollment forms)

Step 3 – Complete enrollment forms, submit them electronically and pay the enrollment fee.

Step 4 – CCA will reach out to you to schedule a time for a “grade level readiness assessment” for your student. Families will be asked to fill out a records request authorization form so we can request records from their previous school (not needed for incoming kindergarteners). We will also need immunization records turned in to the office before the first day of school. Enrollment is finalized after assessments and records are reviewed by the administration, and placement is confirmed.

4. What are your school hours? Do you offer before and after school care?

Our school day is from 8:30 a.m. (classroom doors open at 8:15 a.m.) until 3:00 p.m. Our Early Childhood Department runs our Before & After School Care program, and enrollment in that program is required. 5. Is there a deadline for enrolling?

Classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis until they are full. Returning families get a two-week window to re-enroll before enrollment opens to the public. (Re-enrollment opens February 1st, 2021 for current families, and open enrollment begins on February 15th.) Once classes are full, we will start a waiting list for those grades.
